Updated letter from Tameside Population Health

I have recently emailed you an updated letter from population health, Tameside. There is also a copy in the covid-19 updates section of the school website. The letter is in response to raising rates of cases of covid-19 in the local area in primary aged children. In the letter population health are asking for your support, as are we, and to tell you about some new measures that are being introduced in primary schools. These measures will be in place for at least the next four weeks, and we will be reviewed ready for the new term starting Tuesday 4 January 2022.

One of the key changes is that we are now asking for you to wear Face Coverings in School again when dropping off and picking up your children, or at any time you are on the school site. Thank you for your support with this.

Christmas Cards

We are approaching December when the children will be asking about bringing Christmas cards into school. If you decide that you would like your child to bring in Christmas cards from December 1st, then they can choose to do one of the following:

- To bring in one card for the whole class to share or
- Bring in individual cards. We will only be sharing cards between classes between class 8-10 as one group in school, between classes 5-7 as another, between classes 2-4 as another and within class one on its own.
