We are committed to delivering excellent school dinners.

Lunchtime is more than a nutritious meal, it is an opportunity to relax and socialise and for pupils taking a school lunch we provide a wide choice which is appealing to young people.

Children in Reception, Year One and Year Two (sometimes called Key Stage 1) have their school dinner 'on-the-house'; free, paid for from general taxation by the Government, because good food provision in schools has been shown to lead, not only to healthier children, but to improved attainment.

Whether or not your child eats for free, it is important to us that each and every young person enjoys their meal and has the energy to study and learn in the afternoon. To make sure that your young one gets the meal of their choice we give you the opportunity to pre-order the meal. It is quite simple really, all you have to do is provide a working email address to your school office (see tear-off form below), who will then arrange for your Live Kitchen account to be created. By accessing Live Kitchen online, you will be able to order meals of choice for your child and look up our recipes to check what we put into our meals. Your Email address will only ever be used for the purposes of logging in and as a means of contact from Live Kitchen (so no junk Email). Once you have the login, as well as ordering the meal of choice for your child, you can look up our recipes to check what we put into our meals which are, in the main, freshly cooked from raw ingredients.

It is important for all parents to register their child/children. Should you wish to change from packed lunch to school meals this the only way that you will be able to do so.
