Message from the Headteacher


Harvest Service

Parking near School

For the safety of all coming to and from school, please do not drive vehicles down Richmond St at drop off and pick up times. Please do not park in this area or in the immediate areas around school. Also areas such as the nursery near school, care homes and doctor's surgery are private parking areas. If you are coming in a vehicle, please make use of the church car park across the road at these times. There has been unsafe parking seen including the mounting of kerbs, parking on the yellow zig lines and parking in front of the school gates. This is blocking the safe passage of all pedestrians including those with prams, buggies and very young children.
