Write a diary entry recounting a day in your life:</p> <p>Remember:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write in the past tense and 1st person • Fronted adverbs of time (Yesterday...Later that day... A while later...) • Rhetorical questions • Lots of thoughts and feelings • Check your punctuation and spelling 	<p>Use this story starter: The day had come... they had been warned... they hadn't listened and now it was happening...</p> <p>Remember:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write in the past tense • Ambitious vocabulary • Short, sharp sentences to build suspense • Similes and metaphors • Conjunctions to link your ideas (while, because, although, when) • Check your punctuation and spelling 	<p>Today's setting: A field full of flowers</p> <p>Imagine you are lay in a field full of the most beautiful flowers. Write a detailed description.</p> <p>Remember:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use your senses (see, hear, smell, feel) • Interesting adjectives • Similes and metaphors • Conjunctions to link your ideas (while, because, although, when) • Check your punctuation and spelling
